The first one is a classic.

The Black Pennel

Is from H.Cholmendeley Pennel from England.

This simple fly is mainly for lake trout, sea trout and Atlantic salmon.

However, due to its black colour it also works very well for us.

Material list:

Hook: Wet fly hook size 10-14.
Tying thread: Black
Tail: Gold pheasant tippet
Body: Black Floss
Ribbing: Oval Silver Tinsel
Hackle: Black hen feather
